Frequently asked questions

What are the services I may expect in an inpatient hospice?

The hospice care team, consisting of various healthcare professionals such as doctors, nurses, medical social workers, counsellors and therapists, brings comfort for the patient and his or her loved ones through:

- Specialist palliative care focusing on the management of symptoms such as pain, breathlessness, nausea and vomiting
- Emotional, spiritual and grief support and counselling
- Palliative rehabilitation, including physiotherapy and occupational therapy
- Music and art therapy



Who is eligible and how is the application made?

Anyone who is identified by their doctor to have an advanced and progressive life-limiting illness needing specialised care, especially in the last phase of life when care at home is not possible. Application can be made by any medical doctor caring for the patient. Upon review of the application, the hospice will inform your referring doctor/institution on the application outcome. Approved applications will then be allocated a date for the hospice admission.



Which is the most suitable inpatient hospice for me or my loved one?

All inpatient hospice healthcare teams are equipped with specialised knowledge and skills to care for you and your loved one. You may wish to discuss with your healthcare workers and consider the following when deciding on the choice of hospice:

- The distance of the hospice from your home (to ensure it is convenient for you and/or your loved ones to visit)
- Browse the websites of the hospices for more information
- Call for an appointment to visit or enquire about the hospice(s) during office hours

Does my religion affect which hospice I should choose?

No. All hospices provide equal care to patients of various religions. If you have specific religious practices in mind, feel free to discuss this with your palliative care team on how your care can be tailored to meet your needs.

How much will it cost?

- No one requiring hospice care will be denied care or treatment because of cost.
- Daily inpatient hospice bed charges are independent of ward type and subject to subsidies based on MOH household means testing. This means that patients from lower-income households will receive more subsidies than those from higher-income households.
- Published bed charges may be found on individual hospices' websites.
- The referring doctor/institution would not be able to advise on exact charges as they may include extra treatment, services and/or non-standard consumables and medications needed in the hospice.
- Financial assistance is available for those who require and qualify for additional financial aid. You may approach your medical social worker if you have further financial concerns.
